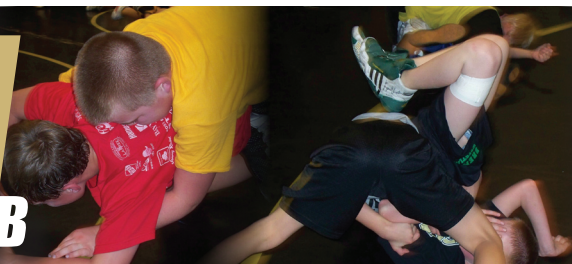

Oberfell Lorber, we have become a non

hours processing the legal documents
needed to incorporate, which will now
allow us access to state funds, save
money on travel and provide a tax write
off for those interested in contributing
